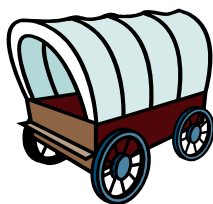

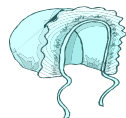

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

1) Each camper and volunteer must fill out and complete a Day Camp Registration form (see included registration forms).

2) Mail completed forms(s) with a check or money order payable to "Coyote Hills Girl Scouts" and a **self-addressed, stamped #10 business envelope** (the long one) for each camper to:

- 3) Checks will not be cashed until registration is confirmed. Confirmation packets will include camp details, and will be mailed in May with forms that must be completed and returned before camp.
- 4) Girls are placed on a first-come, first-served basis, in small units by age, rather than by troop.
- 5) Written refund requests must be received by the Day Camp Registrar at least seven (7) days before day camp begins and are subject to a \$25 cancellation fee after June 1. Refunds will be mailed by October 2011.
- 6) Girls can register for one or both sessions, but must indicate their preferred first choice. Placement in their second choice session depends on space availability. There will be a lottery for girls to attend a second camp session.
- 7) There is a \$15 charge for each returned check.
- 8) Online registration will be available after March 6th at http://www.coyotehillsgs.org/day_camp.html.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Earn discounts for your camper by volunteering !!!

We Need You!!! Coyote Hills Day Camp is run solely by volunteers! We need adults and experienced Program Aides (Older Girls ages 11 – 17 that have completed Program Aide Training) to join our Day Camp Staff. We must have at least one adult volunteer for every six children (campers, Program Aides, Tags and Pixies) attending camp. No prior experience needed, only the desire to work with girls and other adults. You will build new friendships, have fun, and make a difference in many girls' lives!

Work all five (5) days and receive a 50% discount on your camper's fees. If you can work 3-4 days you will receive a 25% discount on your camper's fees.

- 1) Volunteer to work a minimum of three days of day camp (for each session that you/your camper want(s) to attend).
- 2) On-site care is available for volunteers' children/wards during the hours that the volunteer is working at camp, for \$20/child. Children must be potty-trained. Boys and girls ages 3 – 5 are "Pixies." Boys ages 5 – 12 are "Tags." For July girls entering 4 - 6th grade are camper age and must attend as a camper paying the appropriate fees (discounted w/qualifying adult participation) For August girls entering 4 - 6th grade will participate in a Junior/Cadette Unit for \$20 /child Junior camp volunteers: Pixies/Tags must leave by 9:00 p.m. Friday night. Plan ahead for their pick-up if you are staying overnight.
- 3) We provide you with training (18 hours of pre-camp training for all new staff, 10 hours for all second year staff, and 5 hours for all staff who have been with the same camp at the same location for more than 2 years) to learn the skills you need to be an effective day camp volunteer.
- 4) If you commit to the required volunteer training hours, and to work at least three days at day camp, your camper is guaranteed a place in day camp for that session. Confirmation packets will be distributed at training.
